WHO?

Brooke India is an animal welfare organization recognized by the Animal Welfare Board of India and wholly affiliated to Brooke UK (www.thebrooke.org). It has been operational in India since 2000.

Brooke's vision is of a world in which working horses, donkeys and mules are free from suffering.

Our mission in India is to transform the lives of vulnerable working horses, donkeys and mules. We relieve their immediate suffering and create lasting change by working with people, communities and organizations.

WHAT?

Brooke India's Multi Year Plan 17-21 aims to deliver sustainable change for some 300,000 working equines at a cost of c. IR 160m

Brooke works through local partner organisations and with a direct staff team of around 150 men and women. Brooke India combines direct work in communities across different types of work and livelihoods with strong engagement with influencers to create a policy environment that recognises the value of working animals in several different states.

Work types include tourism and shrines; brick kilns; and agriculture and small industry. Interventions include supporting communities to manage and care for their animals and supporting health care services for them. Brooke India has supported disease control and lobbies for improved training of health care providers.
