



Research Assistant (casual worker)

We're looking for a research assistant to join the research team at Brooke on a temporary basis. We need assistance to conduct two literature reviews, which will be used to help inform our field research. The topics will include areas in relation to the economic contribution of equids, equid welfare, and service seeking behaviour of livestock and equine owners in low and middle-income countries.

Role details

- Conduct in depth literature review(s) using robust on-line sources (primary peer-reviewed scientific literature).
- Report writing- literature review write up using an accessible format (with all sources listed) which can be used to inform the development of our field research methodologies.

Experience and qualifications

- Educated to an undergraduate degree level or higher (preferable in a biological or social science subject).
- Excellent written and spoken English skills
- Proven experience of conducting literature reviews using scientific sources.
- Ability to work independently with little supervision.
- Strong time management skills, with the ability to manage your own time to meet the agreed deadlines.
- An interest and knowledge in animal welfare issues is desirable.

We anticipate that each literature review will take approximately 7 days. The successful candidate can either work full or part time and can choose their own hours.

If based in London we would like the research assistant to work from the London office, however if based outside of London we will consider the option to work remotely.
