CROCHET PURPLE POPPY

These little purple crochet poppies can be made and sold at local events in your area. The money you raise can be donated to Brooke to help working horses, donkeys and mules around the world.

Instructions

These little crochet poppies are quite easy to make and are popular at various fundraising events. If this is your first time crocheting, there are many videos online which can help you get started and learn how to crochet.

You will need

- Yarn in black and purples
- Crochet hook

Pattern

- Start with black yarn, and make a magic circle
- Do 12 single crochets into the ring and join with a slip stitch, change to purple yarn bringing through the purple yarn
- Chain 4
- Then 3 treble crochets into the next loop and 3 treble crochets into the next loop
- Chain 4, then join into next loop with a slip stitch. This makes the first petal of your poppy
- Continue from chain 4 for a further 3 petals, fasten off and this completes your 4 petal poppy
